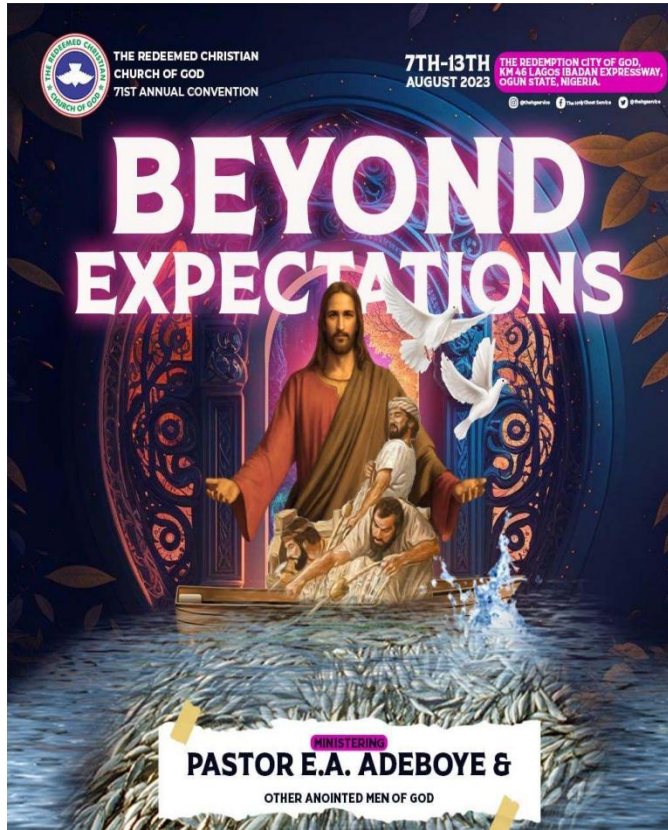

Key Prayer Requests
