KEY SPIRITUAL AND DEVELOPMENTAL ACTIVITIES IN EMR REGION 1

JANUARY

The Netherlands Mission held her first **Monthly Prayer Assembly** which takes place on the first Monday of every month on January 1st 2024. The Europe Continent held a **special send-forth ceremony** in honour of the outgoing Continental Overseer and his wife Pastors Dele and Bukky Olowu on Saturday the 6th of January. She held her **Annual Thanksgiving** in various parishes on January 7. The Region participated actively in the **Europe Continent Fasting and Prayers Quake** that took place from the 8-12th January. This was hosted by the new RCCG Europe Continental Overseer (Pastor Leke Sanusi) and the theme was **"The Wind of Change"**. The region also actively participated in the RCCG Global **50 days Fasting and Prayers** starting from 11th of January and ended on the 29th of February, 2024. The theme for the fasting and the prayers is **"LET THE WIND BLOW"**. The quarterly Online Prayers meeting of the Europe Mainland School of Disciples took place on January 15.

FEBRUARY

The Region held her **Workers and Ministers' Retreat** on Saturday February 3, 2024. The Theme was: **"... and there remaineth yet very much land to be possessed"**. The guest minister was the new Continental Overseer, RCCG Europe, Pastor Leke Sanusi. The convener and chief host was the regional pastor for EMR1, Pastor Bola Lasisi, who also shared his vision for the region while speaking on the message titled **"...there remaineth yet very much land to be possessed"**.

The Region held her **Monthly Early Morning Fire (EMF) program** which takes place on the second Saturday of (nearly) every month on FEBRUARY 10, 2024. The Theme was: The Power of Testimonies. The guest minister was Pastor Mike Nwanegbo, Acting Regional Pastor for Europe Mainland region 6.

The Region hosted the annual **Regional Ladies Conference** in Amsterdam from 16th – 17th February, 2024. **The Theme was: Women of The Right Hand.** The guest minister was Pastor Dr. Grace Sola-Oludoyi. The chief host was Pastor Mrs Lola Lasisi, wife of the regional pastor.

The region participated in the **Global Prayer Walk** in various parishes on FEBRUARY 18. The Region also participated actively in the **RCCG Global 50 days of Fasting and Prayers Program** that ran from January 11th to February 29th, 2024.

The **Marathon Messiah's Praise** (MMP) was held in the month of February for 82 hours non-stop as part of the events to celebrate God's faithfulness in the life of our Daddy, the General Overseer, Pastor Enoch A. Adeboye who turned 82 this year. The Netherlands altar featured in the MMP on Sunday 26th February, and was aired from the regional headquarters parish in Den Haag. Key Prayer Requests

Corporate (Christian) Social Responsibilities (CSR):

PROVINCE 1

JHA Amsterdam

1. Covid-19 Support: Since 2020, the church has regularly provided palliatives to families and university students who are far from home. This package of food supplies is distributed every Sunday after our church services.
2. Furthermore, welfare support in form of cash gifts and moral support is provided to families who have been bereaved; or are in one problem or the other.
3. Training Programs on financial empowerment, and family life improvement services are organized periodically.
4. Providing a platform for expression and creativity for the youths through the regularly organized youth programs.
5. A special weekly meeting organized for youths to discuss pressing social issues, to pray, and to build healthy relationships.
6. The church has also provided help for those fleeing from the Ukraine war by providing access to helpful information for their re-settlement here in the Netherlands. In recent times, some of them who have no jobs are given financial supports.
7. JHA also supports missions to different cities and countries (Africa Missions) through financial donations and providing essential items such as clothing, toys, shoes etc. Furthermore, the church always seeks ways to morally support and encourage Christians in these countries who are suffering persecution for their faith, Orphans, Widows/Widowers, single parents, the needy, etc. Recently, the JHA Youths gathered clothes, shoes and other accessories for this purpose.



PROVINCE 2

BTS

1. Two classes of Dutch school still running.
2. Monthly food packs served to the whole congregation at the BTS and Katwijk
3. A theology student from Sweden, Sis Sara Lovemo, was hosted on industrial attachment from January to March. She was supported with monthly stipend by the parish.
4. The BTS (that now doubles as the Netherlands National and Regional Headquarter parish) hosted the Den Haag interdenominational Christian body on January 20 under the umbrella of EMPOWERED21. The programme was well attended by members of the various Churches.

TOD

- 1. STREET EVANGELISM** - TOD in combination with BTS have street evangelism to reach out to people in the Centrum and open market areas of Den Haag. This is done regularly
- 2. FEEDING THE POOR** - Feeding the poor and homeless in Den Haag in conjunction with some indigenous churches every Saturday
- 3. TOUCH OF FIRE SERIES**-This is a monthly programme that helps to deal with personal and spiritual issues
