The total average attendance across the region is 2,732 compared to 2,777 in the previous quarter of 2024. This represents a 1.6% decline in attendance in this quarter of 2024. The slight decline in attendance compared to the previous quarter was due to the restructuring exercise in Europe Mainland.

KEY SPIRITUAL AND DEVELOPMENTAL ACTIVITIES IN EMR REGION 1

SEPTEMBER

The Region participated in the **RCCG WORKERS' RALLY** which held at the RCCG UK Redemption Camp Ground at Pierrepont on Tuesday 10th October, 2024. The program held live at the Redemption Camp and was followed by the **FOL Partners Meeting with Daddy GO** on Wednesday 11th October, and the **FOL London** event that held at the EXCEL London exhibition center on Friday 13th September, 2024. The UK Convention was concluded on Sunday at the RCCG UK Redemption Camp with ordination of various categories of Pastors on Sunday, September 15. 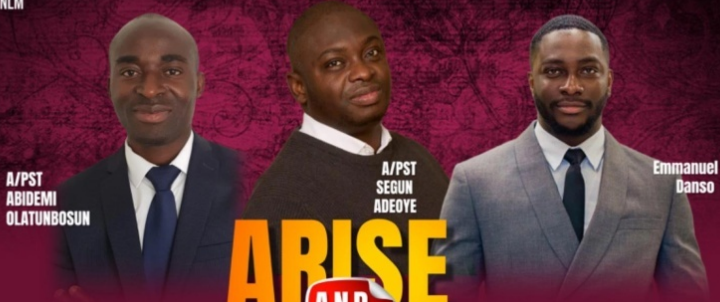

AREAS REQUIRING SPECIAL PRAYERS

Key Prayer Requests

- a. God should send more committed labourers into Europe to further enhance the spread of the Gospel.
- b. Grace, wisdom and courage to make the necessary moves and adjustments that will enable us to reach the indigenes of Europe, with signs and wonders made manifest through us.
- c. God should grant that special miracles be wrought through us so that His church can multiply greatly.
- d. Sustained prayers needed for the new leaders across the continent, and for growth, unity, healing, promotion, favour, open doors, expansion, divine intervention, marriages etc.
- e. Funding: The Parishes need funding as most Parishes are struggling to remit promptly. Majority of them are only paying rent to landlords and thus can hardly sustain themselves.
- f. The Residence Permit to Netherlands hinders ability to bring in Local Pastors. Language constraint, stringent conditions and high cost for "skilled migrants".
- g. Migration/ relocation of the brethren to English speaking countries continue to drain the limited manpower for our parishes.
