Above is the overview of the attendance across the region during the period under review. The total average attendance across the region is 1,697 compared to 2,732 in the previous quarter. This represents a 60.99% decline in attendance in this quarter. The decline in average attendance compared to the previous quarter was due to the restructuring exercise in Europe Mainland that moved France Mission (previous Province 3) and Bulgaria to other regions in the continent.

RCCG EMR1 comprises three (3) provinces and two mission fields namely:

1. Province 1 – Covers the Netherlands (East, Central, North 1 and 2)
2. Province 2 – Covers the Netherlands (West 1, 2 and 3; South 1, 2 and 3)
3. Province 3 – Covers Austria
4. BOSNIA – still a mission field with 3 parishes and 3 house fellowship centers.
5. Montenegro – Nil parishes at the moment. We are currently scouting.

KEY SPIRITUAL AND DEVELOPMENTAL ACTIVITIES IN EMR REGION 1

DECEMBER

The Region equally participated in the **RCCG EUROPE CONTINENTAL PRAYER CONFERENCE** which was held virtually across the continent on Saturday 7th DECEMBER, 2024. The Theme was: **PRAY AGAIN**. The main facilitators were the PRAYER SATCOs, and the chief host was the Continental Overseer, Pastor Leke Sanusi.

The EMR1 participated in the Continental Elders Annual Praise night held on December 19, with the theme "God of Abundance". Our Regional Pastor, Pastor Bola Lasisi was the main speaker.

The Region participated in the **GLOBAL ANNUAL DECEMBER HOLYGHOST CONGRESS** which was held from 9th to 15th December, 2024 at the International Headquarters of the RCCG, Redemption City, Mowe, Ogun State, Nigeria. The congress was also streamed online for all to view and participate. The Theme was: **Onward Christian Soldier!** The regional pastor and his wife were in attendance, likewise the province 1 pastor and the wife of the APICR/PICP 3, Pastor Mrs. Taiwo.

The **RCCG EMR1 Provinces 1, 2 and 3** participated in the **Continental Let's Go A-Fishing program** which held across the various provinces in the continent from Friday 20th – Sunday 22nd December, 2024. The theme was: **"Joy to The World"**. It was indeed a wonderful opportunity for outreach, church strengthening and church planting across the continent. The harsh winter weather posed some challenges, but the program was a huge success in many provinces and locations.

JANUARY

AREAS REQUIRING SPECIAL PRAYERS

Key Prayer Requests

- a. God should send more committed labourers into Europe to further enhance the spread of the Gospel.
- b. Grace, wisdom and courage to make the necessary moves and adjustments that will enable us to reach the indigenes of Europe, with signs and wonders made manifest through us.
- c. God should grant that special miracles be wrought through us so that His church can multiply greatly.

- g. Migration/ relocation of the brethren to English speaking countries continue to drain the limited manpower for our parishes.
