Above is the overview of the attendance across the region during the period under review. The total average attendance across the region is 1,809 compared to 1,697 in the previous quarter. This represents a 6.6% increase in attendance in this quarter.

1. Province 1 – Covers the Netherlands (East, Central, North 1 and 2)
2. Province 2 – Covers the Netherlands (West 1, 2 and 3; South 1, 2 and 3)
3. Province 3 – Covers Austria
4. BOSNIA – still a mission field with 2 parishes and 5 house fellowship/ bible study centers.
5. Montenegro – Nil parishes at the moment. We are currently scouting.

KEY SPIRITUAL AND DEVELOPMENTAL ACTIVITIES IN EM REGION 1

MARCH

The Region actively participated in the **RCCG GLOBAL 100 DAYS PRAYER AND FASTING FOR 2025** which commenced on FEBRUARY 11, 2025 and was concluded on 20th April, 2025. Many parishes in the region met daily to pray, mostly virtually and sometimes in person. God remained very faithful.

The Region joined the rest of the global mission to celebrate **the 83rd birthday** of our father in the Lord, Pastor E. A. Adeboye in March. We thank God for His preservation and sustenance.

The Region fully participated in the **Solemn Assembly and the RCCG SPECIAL HOLY GHOST SERVICE 2025** which held at the RCCG Redemption City, Mowe, Ogun State, Nigeria from 4th to 5th and 6th to 9th March, 2025 respectively. The theme of the event was **JOY UNSPEAKABLE**, and our father in the Lord, Daddy E.A. Adeboye was the convener and the key speaker.

The Continent held a special **Church Planters Course** on Saturday 14th, 21st and 28th March, 2025. The course was put together by the Continental Office and the sessions were facilitated by several anointed servants of God, including the CO, DCO, ACOs, Continental Directors, Youth Pastors and others. It was 3 Saturdays of insightful teachings and fruitful conversations around the nature and key strategies for successful Church Planting in Europe.

The Regional Pastor and his wife paid a mission trip visit to RCCG BOSNIA MISSION from Friday March 21st to Monday March 24th, 2025. They ministered to several of the indigenes during the visit and also presented gifts from the region to the members of RCCG Bosnia mission and their family members. Some souls were saved during the mission trip. By the grace of God, the church in Bosnia is doing well and they are grateful to God for His faithfulness over the years and they truly appreciated the visit. They have some pictures from the mission trip below.

APRIL

The Region actively participated in the **RCCG CONTINENT'S PUBLIC LEADERSHIP GATHERING** which held virtually on **April 1, 2025** and was facilitated by the Continental Overseer, Pastor Leke Sanusi, Reverend Yemi Adedeji, and other senior pastors from various regions of the

continent. It was an opportunity to challenge ourselves to be more involved in the local politics and community leadership in our various jurisdictions. Several RCCG leaders and members who are currently serving in the public space shared their experiences.

The Continent held a special **Emerging Leaders Church Planters Course** on Saturday **5th and 12th APRIL, 2025**. The course was put together by the Continental Office and the sessions were facilitated by several anointed servants of God (mostly young leaders themselves), and also the CO, DCO, and others. It was 2 Saturdays of very insightful teachings and fruitful conversations around key strategies for successfully Planting Youth Churches in Europe.

The Region fully participated in the **Workers Rally 2025** which held virtually and was viewed live at multiple viewing centers across the continent on **Tuesday 15th APRIL, 2025**. The theme of the event was **LANDMARK**, and our father in the Lord, Daddy E.A. Adeboye was the convener and the key speaker.

RCCG Europe Continent **Easter Let's-Go-A-Fishing** held on Friday 18th and Saturday 19th April, 2025. The 3 provinces of the region actively participated in the outreach program in different cities in both The Netherlands and Austria. Province 1 held their outreach in the city of Lelystad, while Province 2 had theirs in the city of Utrecht. Some members of the Regional HQ parish (BTS) joined in the outreach in Utrecht vicinity. Province 3 held their outreach across 5 cities in Austria. Overall, the outreaches recorded a total of 8 saved souls and some new Home Connect Centres were established.

The Region actively participated in the **RCCG GLOBAL 100 DAYS PRAYER AND FASTING FOR 2025** which commenced on January 11, 2025 and was **concluded on Sunday 20th April, 2025**. Many parishes in the region celebrated God's faithfulness throughout the period of the fast.

The Region joined the rest of the continental mission for the **Continental Ordained Ministers Conference (COMC) 2025**, which held at the Redemption Camp in Pierrepont, Frensham Road, Farnham, UK from **24th to 26th April, 2025**. The theme of the Conference was: **LANDMARK**. Our father in the Lord, Pastor E. A. Adeboye and Mummy Folu Adeboye were the main speakers. We thank God for His mighty presence and for the great mobilization towards planting Youth churches.

MAY

The Netherlands Mission held her **QUARTERLY EARLY MORNING FIRE (EMF) PROGRAM** which was held at Jesus House, Amsterdam on MAY 10th 2025. The Theme was: **God is Faithful**. The guest minister was Pastor Paul Awede, PICR for EMR8. The Regional Pastor was the chief host.

The Continent held a special **LIGHT UP ITALY event** on Wednesday 14th **MAY**, 2025. The theme of the event was **LET THERE BE LIGHT**, and our father in the Lord, Daddy E.A. Adeboye was the convener and the key speaker. Several other indigenous speakers as well as anointed gospel ministers were there to glorify God in an atmosphere of deep worship and high praise. The Regional Pastor and his wife and some other ministers and members participated in the programme.

The Regional Pastor and his wife joined some other senior Pastors in the continent, that include Pastor Dele Olowu (COE), the CO, the DCO and other senior pastors to attend the **25th anniversary of the Apostolic Fellowship International (AFI)** after the "Light Up Milan" programme from May 15-17 at Napples, Italy where Daddy GO, Pastor E.A. Adeboye was the guest speaker. It was very awesome.

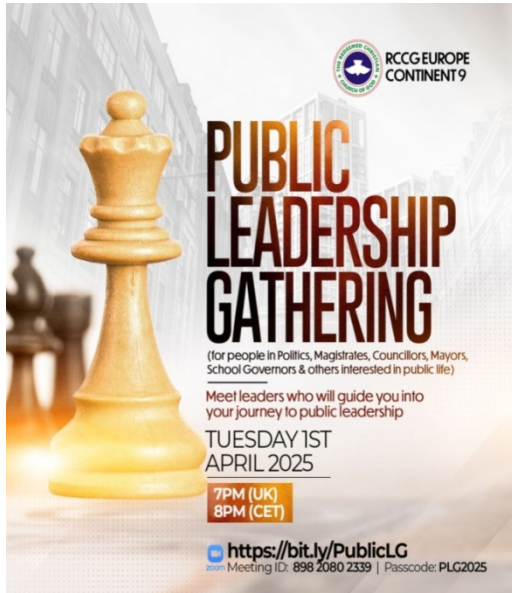

AREAS REQUIRING SPECIAL PRAYERS

Key Prayer Requests

- a. God should send more committed labourers into His Church to further enhance the spread of the Gospel.
- b. Grace, wisdom and courage to make the necessary moves and adjustments that will enable us to reach the indigenes of Europe, with signs and wonders made manifest through us.
- c. God should grant that special miracles be wrought through us so that His church can multiply greatly.
- d. Sustained prayers needed for the new leaders across the continent, and for growth, unity, healing, promotion, favour, open doors, expansion, divine intervention, marriages etc.
- e. Funding: The LORD should touch the heart of most of our ministers and workers to be more faithful in tithing and sowing to the kingdom business.
- f. The Residence Permit to Netherlands hinders ability to bring in Local Pastors. Language constraint, stringent conditions and high cost for “skilled migrants”.
- g. Migration/ relocation of the brethren to English speaking countries continue to drain the limited manpower for our parishes.

21. Sister had not visited her son in 17 years due to visa denials, but was by God's grace able to do so this year.
22. Sister and her family had a car accident that would have been deadly/catastrophic in normal circumstances, but the family got away unscathed, to the glory of God.

23. God's mercy and faithfulness were once again made evident in the life of Sister Sonia Mascot, who was granted permanent stay in the Netherlands from an asylum position. This miracle adds to the chain of divine interventions we have witnessed in recent months and stands as a powerful reminder that the prayers of the saints do not go unanswered. - Immigration Support: Ongoing spiritual and emotional support was offered to members navigating immigration challenges. Sister Ruth's testimony has greatly encouraged others in similar situations.

In May: The testimony of Sister Sonia underscores the effectiveness and impact of our CSR initiatives. Under the auspices of Daddy and Mummy Lasisi, the church demonstrated Christian compassion and unwavering support, which left a lasting impression on healthcare workers, legal representatives, and government officials. This kind of tangible love and support remains central to our mission and ministry in the community.

They also had on the spot revival programme at every one of the five locations visited and prayed for the sick and those trusting the Almighty for an intervention. It is also worth mentioning that Lagos Province 45 that has been sponsoring the Bosnia Mission in the last ten years had informed us of their desire to discontinue the sponsorship at the end of June 2025. We trust God and we pray that this will not become a major setback because the Churches in Eastern Europe are still largely mission field and rarely survive without sponsorship.

We ask for continued prayers of the Home Mission to enable us to surmount all the challenges currently facing the mission in our region and other parts of the continent.
