Above is the overview of the attendance across the region during the period under review. The total average attendance across the region is 1,670 compared to 1,809 in the previous quarter. This represents a 8.3% decline in attendance in this quarter. The main reason for the decline was that most of our brethren go on summer vacation in the months of June, July and August –Some Churches actually closedown for a month or two during summer period in Western Europe.

RCCG EMR1 comprises of the Regional headquarter, three (3) provinces and two mission fields namely:

1. Regional headquarter parish – The Breakthrough Sanctuary.
2. Province 1 – Covers the Netherlands (East, Central, North 1 and 2)
3. Province 2 – Covers the Netherlands (West 1, 2 and 3; South 1, 2 and 3)
4. Province 3 – Covers Austria
5. BOSNIA – still a mission field with 1 parish now (the 2nd was shut down) and 5 house fellowship/ bible study centers.
6. Montenegro – Nil parishes at the moment. We are currently scouting.

AUGUST

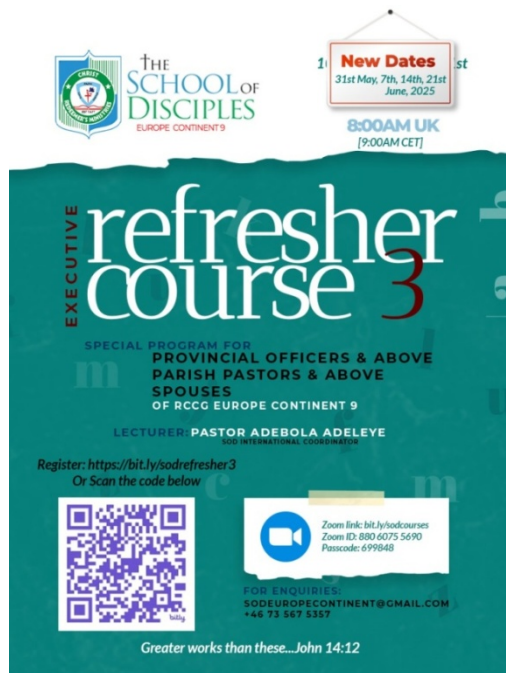
