4. Province 3 – Covers Austria
5. BOSNIA – still a mission field with 1 parish now (the 2nd was shut down) and 5 house fellowship/ bible study centers.
6. Montenegro – Nil parishes at the moment. We are currently scouting.

KEY SPIRITUAL AND DEVELOPMENTAL ACTIVITIES IN EM REGION 1

SEPTEMBER

The REGION participated in the **RCCG EUROPE CONTINENT 9 MEETING FOR ALL PARISH PASTORS ACROSS THE CONTINENT**. The special meeting held online via Zoom and was hosted by the Continental Overseer, Pastor Leke Sanusi. It held on Saturday 6th September at 8am CET. It was well attended by pastors from several countries across the continent.

The Region participated in the **Continental Workers Rally** themed: **DIVINE INTERVENTION** which held as a multi-site event via zoom on Tuesday SEPTEMBER 16th, 2025. The main speaker was The General Overseer, **Pastor E. A. Adeboye**. He spoke passionately to all RCCG Workers and answered very important questions that were put together by the YAYA group. Participants joined from across the continent (UK, ROI and Europe Mainland) from 8pm to 11:00pm CET.

The REGION participated in the **FESTIVAL OF LIFE (FOL) LONDON** organized by the RCCG FOL TEAM, tagged **DIVINE INTERVENTION** on SEPTEMBER 19TH 2025. The event held at the EXCEL London Arena and attracted several thousands of participants from all walks of life. Adeboye was the main speaker and he ministered powerfully with the power of The Holy Spirit.

The regional headquarters parish held her **monthly POWER Night** on Friday SEPTEMBER 26th, 2025. The regional pastor, Pastor Bola Lasisi and other ministers of God led the service. The service was hybrid; face2face and virtual. The theme was "The Miracle Worker".

Key Prayer Requests

- a. God should send more committed labourers into His Church to further enhance the spread of the Gospel.

18. Divine Help and Mercy at Work - A sister testified to the glory of God for His intervention in her workplace. She shared that she made an error that could have had serious consequences for her career. However, God used her boss and other members of staff to support her and help her correct the mistake. She expressed deep gratitude to God for turning the situation around and ensuring that it did not negatively affect her professional journey.

19. Victory During Workplace Inspection - A brother testified of God's remarkable help in overcoming significant pressure and challenges at work. He explained that he was concerned about an upcoming inspection; particularly because there is shortage of staff and his position as a manager could have been affected if the outcome was poor. To the glory of God, the inspection was successful, and everything went smoothly. He also received commendation from his superiors for the excellent results. He thanked God for His Favor, guidance, and support throughout the process.

20. A sister gave glory to God for His help and defense at her workplace. She shared how some of her colleagues conspired against her and tried to sabotage her. Through it all, God stood by her, defended her, and put the plans of the enemy to shame. Glory to God for His constant protection and victory!
